



POINT MUGU SEA RANGE EIS/OEIS

The U.S. Navy invites you to participate in the Point Mugu Sea Range Environmental Impact Statement/Overseas Environmental Impact Statement (EIS/OEIS) public involvement process.

The Navy has prepared a Draft EIS/OEIS to assess potential environmental consequences associated with continuing military readiness activities and proposed increases in research, development, acquisition, testing, evaluation, and training activities in the Point Mugu Sea Range. These activities are consistent with previously analyzed activities and are similar to those that have occurred here for decades.

The Navy is also consulting with interested parties for the National Historic Preservation Act Section 106 process regarding potential effects on historic properties.
