



## **Record of Decision for the Point Mugu Sea Range Final EIS/OEIS**

### **Notice of Availability**

The U.S. Navy, after carefully weighing the strategic, operational, and environmental consequences of the Proposed Action, is announcing its decision to continue military readiness activities and increase research, development, acquisition, testing, evaluation, and training activities as described in Alternative 1, the Navy's Preferred Alternative, in the Point Mugu Sea Range Final Environmental Impact Statement/Overseas Environmental Impact Statement (EIS/OEIS).

The Navy made this decision after considering military testing and training objectives; best available science; potential impacts activities may have on human, natural, and cultural environments; and input and expertise from elected officials, government agencies, tribes, nongovernmental organizations, and the public on the proposal and environmental analysis.

The Navy is committed to being a good steward of the environment and will continue to implement mitigation measures and standard operating procedures to avoid or reduce potential environmental impacts from testing and training.
